Actions Taken and points of information not on the agenda

Pavilion Soil Survey

The pavilion soil drilling and sampling survey was completed on the 29th March. Drilling was halted at 2.2m. The laboratory report should be available shortly.

Sharpthorne kickabout area:

Mid Sussex annual inspection of the play area has picked up the dip in the surfacing and identified it as low risk- this means that it requires attention, but the risk to play area users is low. Mid Sussex will look to address the issue over the course of the next few months once any urgent matters from the annual inspections have been dealt with.

Schedule of meeting dates

Two changes have been made to the initial draft circulated in February. The meeting of the West Hoathly Village Hall Management Committee in February has been moved to 21st February and the Asset & Highways meeting in March has been moved to the 21st March.

Grant request

A grant request of £500 has been received from Air Ambulance Kent Surrey Sussex to help fund vital pieces of equipment, such as the purchase of 2 new Oxylog 3000+ ventilators.

Correspondence

Correspondence has been received from Mitie Security Ltd who acquired Interserve FM Ltd in December 2020 to advise that the current service agreement ends on the 31/05/2021. Following a review of their services Mitie will be unable to renew the contract and support our systems.
